

SENECA TOWNSHIP
Annual Town Meeting Minutes
April 13, 2010

The Annual Town Meeting for the Township of Seneca, County of McHenry, State of Illinois, was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Clerk Dawn Seemann at the Seneca Township Building located at 16506 Garden Valley Road, Woodstock, Illinois.

Electors Present: Dawn Seemann, Scott Swanson, Don Andrews, Rosemary Bartman, Susan Mathews, Michael O'Leary, Thomas Dahlfors, Marilyn Kelly, James Kagel, and Paul Bockman.

Nomination for Moderator: Michael O'Leary motioned to nominate Marilyn Kelly as tonight's moderator. Second by Thomas Dahlfors. No other nominations were heard. A voice vote was taken to close the nominations and passed.

Oath of Office: The Oath of Office for Moderator was administered to Marilyn Kelly by Clerk Dawn Seemann.

Introduction of Township Officials Present: All of Seneca Township's elected officials were present and introduced.

Purpose of Annual Town Meeting: The purpose of the Annual Town Meeting is so the residents of Seneca Township could come together and discuss what they'd like to see accomplished in their township, as well as make decisions. It gives the residents a chance to voice their opinions.

Reading/Approval of the 2009 Annual Town Meeting Minutes: Rosemary Bartman motioned to waive the reading of the minutes and approve them as presented. Second by Mathews. Motion passed.

Motion to set the 2010-2011 Fiscal Year: Michael O'Leary motioned to set the 2010-2011 Fiscal Year for the Township as April 1, 2010 to March 31, 2011. Second by Thomas Dahlfors. Motion passed.

Motion to set the Date for the 2011 Annual Town Meeting: Dahlfors motioned to set the date for the 2011 Annual Town Meeting for April 12, 2011. James Kagel motioned to set a 6:30 pm start time for the Annual Town Meeting. Second by Dahlfors. Motion passed.

Reading of the Supervisors Annual Report of the Township and Road District for fiscal year April 1, 2009 through March 31, 2010: Clerk Dawn Seemann read aloud the Supervisor's Annual Report of the Township and Road District for fiscal year April 1, 2009 through March 31, 2010. Upon conclusion, Dahlfors motioned to approve the Supervisor's Annual Report. Second

by Mathews. Motion passed.

Other Business to Come Before the Meeting: Don Andrews voiced his concerns and reasons regarding the importance for Seneca Township to provide Pace bus service for its residents. He would like the Seneca Township Board to look into this, and see if the county, Woodstock, and/or Marengo could pick up the cost of it or even a part of it. Mr. Andrews had looked into this himself and found that Pace wanted \$25,000 to provide bus service to Seneca Township.

Motion to Adjourn: At 7:18 p.m. Susan Mathews motioned to adjourn this year's Annual Town Meeting. Second by Scott Swanson. Motion passed.
