<u>Assessor's Report:</u> Bockman informed the board that all the assessment books need to be turned into the county by October; adds the new assessment to the rolls. He stated there have been a lot if new in-ground pools installed.

Old Business:

A. Township Flag Update – Mathews reported her son, Jarrett Mathews' update on the township flag. The flag's fabric is Dacron, and the size is 3' x 5'. - Land Use Law Seminar Kagel informed the board about an upcoming Land Use Law Seminar. The cost to attend is \$349.00 each. The board had no interest in attending due to the cost.
- Audit Kagel stated we are still in need of a third person to help with auditing our books.
