He hopes to have the assessment books turned in to the county by the 1st of June. In addition, the assessor's landline has been eliminated, which saves the township approximately \$100 a month.

## **New Business:**

- **A.** Approve line transfer for Town Fund Kagel transferred \$50.00 from line item 1364 (Internet) to line item 1363 (Phone). Mathews motioned the transfer. Second by Bartman. Voting yes: Bartman, Mathews, Semro, Gerloff, Kagel. Voting no: None. Motion passed.
- **B.** Discuss and/or pass a resolution for participation in IMRF Kagel received a letter from IMRF. Discussion took place about the date the position (Road Commissioner) became qualified for IMRF. Gerloff motioned to table this issue until the question could be answered. Second by Mathews. Motion passed.

<u>Supervisor's Report:</u> Kagel received information from the McHenry County States Attorney regarding Training for Elected Officials. Anyone interested should let Kagel know.

- A consulting firm hired by IDOT would like to use the township building for a meeting for residents who reside on Rt. 176 between Millstream and Dean Street. The board discussed this and approved the firm to use the building for the \$25 non-resident charge.
