<u>Clerk's Report:</u> Seemann informed the board to be "on the lookout" for the Economic of Interest Statement in their mailbox, and be sure to complete and mail it back right away to avoid having to pay a penalty.

<u>Road Commissioner's Report:</u> Swanson reported in addition to plowing, he rented a loader to push back the snow away from the roadways. He added that there is virtually no money left in the Road and Bridge Fund so he took out the CD to put in that fund and will replace it in the summer with another CD.

<u>Assessor's Report:</u> Bockman fielded questions from residents about the assessments going down and taxes going up. In addition, Bockman talked to someone about helping him out with his work. He stated she works approximately 3 days a week (18 hours).

<u>Supervisor's Report:</u> Kagel found an error on the Annual Financial Report, which he has corrected. It was off by \$1000.00 in the Road and Bridge Fund.

- Kagel was questioned on the ownership of the Pioneer Cemetery on South Street. Upon some investigative work, Kagel found it was owned by school district 200.
- There is still an ongoing issue with the Assessor's phone bill that Kagel is still trying to get resolved. The bill went up 50% over a period of 13 months. It has taken 4 phone calls to try and get some satisfaction from AT&T.

<u>Motion to Adjourn:</u> At 7:40 p.m. O'Leary motioned to adjourn tonight's regular monthly meeting. Second by Dahlfors. Motion passed.
