Regular Monthly Meeting July 9, 2019

The Regular Monthly Meeting of the Seneca Township Board of Trustees was called to order at 6:30 pm by Supervisor James Kagel at the Seneca Township Building located at 16506 Garden Valley Road, Woodstock, Illinois.

<u>Township Officials in Attendance:</u> Supervisor James Kagel, Trustees Rosemary Bartman, Susan Mathews, Gerald Gieseks, and Denise Sass, Assessor Tammy Benitez, and Clerk Dawn Seemann. Absent Officials: Road Commissioner Scott Swanson.

<u>Guests in Attendance:</u> Patrick Kenneally, Laura Schrock, Scott Block, Chris Reed, Glen Niezgoda, Tom Zanck, and Brady Coleman, plus others who did not sign in.

Public Speaking: Representatives from New Directions spoke about their request for a zoning change from AG1 to 5 Acre Estate on the property previously used by PADS. They explained that they want to use it for a residential business. They are also asking for a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) and a change in the road frontage requirements. Representatives explained that the property was previously used for the homeless for the last 20 years, which has recently moved to McHenry, and now will be used as an addiction recovery residence with room for thirty three people. This alternative housing program is a peer-to-peer environment helping the residents learn to live in a sobriety society, giving them a great opportunity to help people get back on their feet. New Directions is hoping to get started on the take-over and updates of the property in October, with Spring being projected as the start of moving in. This is a self-funded, non-profit business, with their source of funding being from donations and organizations. Residents will be paying rent. The board will discuss and vote on this during the New Business section of tonight's meeting.

<u>Assessor's Report:</u> Benitez informed the board that she will be turning in the assessment books to the county the 1st week of August. Notices should then go out before the 1st of September.

-Bartman questioned Benitez about the process farmers need to take to reduce their assessments due to not being able to plant all their fields because of the weather? Benitez informed her to contact the County Assessor. She stated she has not had anyone mention this to her yet and she hasn't heard anything about a process.

<u>Minutes:</u> Bartman motioned to approve the June 11, 2019 regular monthly minutes as presented. Second by Gieseke. Motion passed.

Audit of Current Bills:

<u>Treasurer's Report:</u> Kagel informed the board that he made an error on the May Treasurer's Report. The error has been corrected and a copy of the corrected report has been given to the board. Sass motioned to approve and file the corrected May Treasurer's Report. Second by Bartman. Voting yes: Bartman, Mathews, Gieseke, Sass, Kagel. Voting no: None. Motion passed.
