New Business:

A. Possibility of writing letter to ZBA or McHenry County Board giving opinion in Emery Woods property variance - The petitioner has asked for a variance to their property to house two mini horses as comfort animals. The A1 zoning requires a minimum of 2 acres, the property has less than 1.19 acres. This variance request also goes against the subdivision covenant and restrictions. The neighbors of the petitioner have asked Kagel to write a letter against the variance. After discussion among the board, Mathews motioned to approve Kagel to draft a letter to the ZBA against the variance request. Second by Gieseke. Motion passed.

<u>Supervisor's Report:</u> Kagel received information for the 2020 Education District Meeting scheduled for March 21st at Giovanni's in Rockford. Any board member who wants to attend should let Kagel know.
