MCHENRY COUNTY, IL – The McHenry County Department of Health (MCDH), Nunda Township Road District, and Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) are partnering to provide McHenry County residents with a free opportunity to recycle unwanted tires during a two-day event on October 2 and 3.

The event will be held Friday, October 2, and Saturday, October 3, at the Nunda Township Road District (3518 Bay Road in Crystal Lake). Pre-registration is required. Appointments are available beginning at 7 a.m. each day, with the final appointment at 2:45 p.m. Participants should arrive during their assigned 15-minute appointment time.

The event is limited to tires from McHenry County residential properties. The following restrictions apply:

- A maximum of 12 tires per address.
- Only passenger, light truck, and smaller-sized tires will be accepted.
- Tires may be on or off the rim, but must be free of water, mud, and other debris.
- Participants are responsible for unloading their own tires. Tires on rims will be placed in a separate pile from rimless tires.
- Other recyclable materials and waste will not be accepted.
- Tires from businesses or commercial enterprises will NOT be accepted.
